

MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS AND FEES

AT LARGE MEMBER. Includes individuals who will be representing their own radon related concerns and interests as an At Large member. At Large members are typically students, healthcare professionals, community members, etc. However, an At Large member may be employed by an organization, such as a radon mitigation company, hospital or local health department, but is not the official representative of the organization while participating in URC.

The required annual membership fee for Am At Large member is \$50

ORGANIZATIONAL MEMBER. Includes organizations such as those listed in the following classes, each of which will appoint an individual associated with the organization to represent its interest in URC:

- 1. Business. An incorporated or otherwise formed for-profit business that has an interest in and concern about radon but whose products are not primarily founded on radon [real estate, builders, developers, legal, banking, financial, etc.].
- 2. Community Associations. An organization that represents a body of persons of common interests (scientific, educational, medical, etc.) who are interested in and concerned about radon.
- 3. Industry. An incorporated or otherwise formed for-profit business that has an interest in and concern about radon and whose products are primarily founded on radon (radon mitigators, radon testers, radon suppliers, home inspectors, etc.)
- 4. Agency. A non-profit organization (university, hospital, government, etc.), that has an interest in and concern about radon.

The required annual membership fee for an Organizational Member is \$150.
